### 8700.7500 CODE OF ETHICS FOR MINNESOTA TEACHERS.

**Scope.** Each teacher, upon entering the teaching profession, assumes a number of obligations, one of which is to adhere to a set of principles which defines professional conduct. These principles are reflected in the following code of ethics, which sets forth to the education profession and the public it serves standards of professional conduct and procedures for implementation.

This code shall apply to all persons licensed according to rules established by the Board of Teaching.

List the 10 Standards of Professional Conduct. You do not need to write the standards verbatim. You may explain them in your own words.

- A) Disciplinary actions must be reasonable.
- B) A teacher must do their best to ensure the health and safety of their students
- C) A teacher must not share confidential information unless absolutely necessary.
- D) A teacher must not exhibit discriminatory behavior.
- E) A teacher must not use school resources to personal advantage.
- F) If a teacher must delegate their responsibilities, they must be delegated to properly licensed personnel.
- G) A teacher must not alter or withhold any of their subject's content.
- H) A teacher must not falsify or misrepresent their own or others qualifications.
- I) A teacher must not make untrue or malicious comments about staff or students.
- J) A teacher must not accept a position for which they are not properly license.
